All participants will receive a USA Made BUCK knife with their registration!

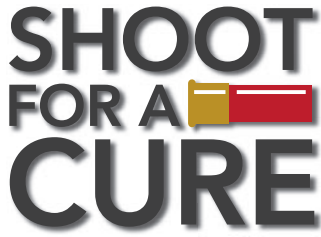
